

## What is infrastructure?

'Infrastructure' is broadly defined in the Town and Country Planning Act 2008.

The three broad categories of infrastructure have been identified as:

### - **Physical infrastructure:**

e.g. highways, transport links, cycle ways, energy supply, water, flood alleviation, waste management.

### - **Social infrastructure:**

e.g. education, health, social care, emergency services, art and culture, sports halls, community halls, faith, crematoria

### - **Green infrastructure:**

e.g. parks, woodlands, play areas, public open space.
